MEMBERSHIP IN THE MISSISSIPPI FREEDOM DEMOCRATIC PARTY, a political organization loyal to the platform and principles of the National Democratic Party is open to all adult residents of the state of Mississippi regardless of race, color or creed.

Because the oppressive policies and discriminatory practices of the state of Mississippi deprive the majority of Negroes of the right to vote, membership in the M.F.D.P. is not dependent on whether or not an individual is registered to vote under present conditions.

All members of the Party are eligible to stand for and to hold any or all positions and offices in the Party.

It is the duty and responsibility of all members to attend and participate in all precinct, district and county meetings, to contribute to the formulation of all policies and to vote in all elections in the Party.

STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY is an association of young people on the left. It seeks to create a sustained community of educational and political concern; one bringing together liberals and radicals, activists and scholars, students and faculty.

It maintains a vision of a democratic society, where at all levels the people have control of the decisions which affect them and the resources on which they are dependent. It seeks a relevance through the continual focus on realities and on the programs necessary to effect change at the most basic levels of economic, political, and social organization. It feels the urgency to put forth a radical, democratic program counterposed to authoritarian movements both of Communism and the domestic Right.

The FIRST AMENDMENT, from the BILL OF RIGHTS

"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."
